The certificates issued in the previous systems are also valid.</p> <p>We suggest making changes of the order of the contents. This could resolve the confusion that Brazil is concerned about.</p>	<p>We propose a restructure of the document by changing the order of term definitions and by adding a statement for utilizing the old test data in the previous systems. Followings explain the procedure for the changes.</p> <p>(1) Move clause 4.1 as the first clause of a new section 7.</p> <p>(2) Rename clause 4.2 as a new section 4</p> <p>(3) Rename clause 4.3 as a new section 5</p> <p>(4) Rename clause 4.4 as a new section 6</p> <p>(5) Move all clauses (5.1 to 5.3) under section 5 as the clauses (7.2 to 7.4) of the new section 7.</p> <p>(6) Create a new clause 2.3 under section 2 describing the use of the old test data obtained in the previous OIML systems. See JP2 for the details.</p> <p>(7) Create clauses 3.1 and 3.2 under section 3, providing the current definitions under the OIML-CS and the definitions in the previous systems, respectively.
