



Update on the OIML R117 Project

OCTOBER 2019

OIML R117 – 2CD

- ▶ Voting and commenting on the 2CD package of R117 closed on 11 March 2019.
- ▶ The **2CD passed with 100% consensus “YES” votes** (zero “no” votes) and 92% participation from the 25 P-members of the Project Group.
- ▶ Received approximately **50 pages of non-editorial comments** on the 2CD package R117.

OIML R117 Project Group Meeting

Cape Town, South Africa (26-29 March 2019)

- ▶ In Cape Town, the R117 PG adhered to the new procedures that should be followed when a significant number of non-editorial comments are received on an "Approved CD" (found in Section 6.4 of OIML B6-1:2017 "Directives for the OIML Technical Work").
- ▶ In order to maximize productivity and efficiency during the meeting, the PG broke up into teams of subject-matter experts for the first 1.5 days of the meeting to resolve international comments and improve the document in specific technical areas.
- ▶ Team Leaders:
 - ▶ Bunkering Team, Wim Volmer (NMI, The Netherlands);
 - ▶ LNG Team, Luciano Burtini (Measurement Canada);
 - ▶ Software Team, Srinivas Bobbala (NZ Trading Standards);
 - ▶ Metering and Gas Elimination Team, Dmitri Karimov (IDEX); and
 - ▶ Fuel Dispenser Team, Mario Zamora (NMI – Australia).
- ▶ **All issues were resolved and a new 3CD of R117 was developed and APPROVED with 100% consensus "yes" votes at the meeting in Cape Town.**

R117 Preliminary Ballot

- ▶ The Preliminary Ballot for all three parts of OIML R117 (~700 pages) was open for CIML vote and comment for 3 months (June – September 2019).
- ▶ CIML voting closed on 25 Sept 2019 with 100% consensus “yes” votes (38 yes votes, zero no votes, zero abstain votes).
- ▶ Only two minor editorial changes have been made based on minor comments received on the POB.
- ▶ R177 has had three rounds of 100% “yes” votes in 2019 and is ready for publication (it does NOT need another round of voting).
